



## Responsibilities for Team Coaches

- Foundation course to be completed with Netball Victoria. KHNC will organise and pay for this course
- Umpiring course to be completed on line through Netball Victoria (this should take about an hour)
- Working With Children clearance needs to be obtained by all adult coaches and a copy given to the club registrar
- Attend team training and weekend matches
- Be involved in your teams warm up training and guide any players that are having difficulties
- You will have 30 minutes with your team each week and half a court to work within
- During the season we will endeavour to play inter club matches to help with positional play and development
- Each week we will focus on a particular skill, any player that does not grasp the skill should be noted and the name given to the coach coordinator
- The coach co-ordinator will endeavour to work with this group of players in a more intense skill session to improve this skill
- Session plans will be given at the start of each training covering the skill and coaching points
- Make a note of any disagreements that arise between players or parents. If at any time you feel you need assistance with an issue, please contact the coach co-ordinator
- Each coach to keep detailed records of training attendance and positions played in each game
- Encourage each player by giving positive feedback
- In the event you have 10 players each week a roster system needs to be put in place to ensure each player gets maximum benefit from longer court time
- At the end of each training session establish who will be attending the next game
- You are responsible for your netball bag and balls
- Medical indemnity forms should remain in the blue bag at all times
